From Albany area and points south:

Follow Rte. 7 across the Hudson River. Turn left (north) onto Rte. 40. Follow 40 to Schaghticoke. Turn right (east) onto Rte. 67 at the Fairgrounds traffic light *Go 5.4 miles. Bear Right onto Marpe Rd. At the stop sign, turn right onto Goosen-Regan Rd. to the barn.

From Clifton Park, Latham, and Colonie:

Take Rte. 67 east through Mechanicville and across the Hudson. Turn left (north) onto Rtes. 40/67, and continue to Schaghticoke. Turn right (east) on Rte 67 at the Fairgrounds traffic light. Continue as above from the *

From Vermont and Southeastern NY:

Take Rte 22 (north or south, depending on where you are coming from) to intersect with Rte. 67 west near Eagle Bridge. The intersection is just north of Hoosick Falls and has a blinking light. Follow 67 west through Buskirk, about 8 miles. The road passes between two small ponds and goes under a railroad trestle. Marpe Rd. is a very sharp left turn right after the railroad trestle. General Information and Policies —It is the responsibility of each competitor to read and understand the current Barn Hunt Association, LLC (BHA) Rules prior to participating in this event. <http://www.barnhunt.com/forms/barnhuntrules.pdf>

Possessing or training with personal tubes and/or live rats is NOT permitted on the event grounds at any time.

Events will be held indoors on packed dirt. Dogs must be leashed or crated when not in the blind or ring. There is no crating in the barn, there is an area available for parking and tents. Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers. Multiple potty areas are available.

Barn Hunt Grounds: Barn Hunt rules apply to any activities held in the barn at LongLesson Farm barn or any where on the site.

Leashes and collars: Head Halters, Bark, Electronic Collars/Devices are NOT allowed on event grounds. Approved collars include: flat snap or buckle collars and leather or nylon leads, limited slip martingale and single piece slip collars/leads, and harnesses. Dogs MUST run “naked,” without a collar/harness. Dogs should be brought to the ring with collars/harnesses which can be easily and quickly removed and replaced. (see BHA Rulebook page 20 for more specifics). Flexi-Leads are NOT allowed on event grounds.

Dog aggression: Any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner toward another dog or person may be dismissed from the event if justification is found by the judge and/or Event Committee. Entry fees will not be refunded.

Bitches in season: Are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will run at the end of their class. They must wear pants at all times (including on course) while not being pottied. They must be pottied in a designated area away from the other dogs. Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until the closing date of September 28, 2017, if you wish to withdraw. The trial secretary must be notified prior to or upon arrival. Failure to do so will result in a disqualification and dismissal from the event.

Videotaping and photography: **Is allowed and encouraged!**

Volunteers: **Are appreciated and needed!**

Spectators: **Are valued and encouraged! Please be sure spectators have a basic understanding of the sport, plus do's and don'ts.**

Sportsmanship: All competitors/handlers and spectators are expected to follow the rules of the BHA and demonstrate good sportsmanship. Please do not discuss hide placement or any

details of a dog's performance that may provide information or clues to other handlers or may be overheard. Please be cognizant of teams competing in the ring and avoid loud or disruptive distractions.

Crating: Dogs must be leashed or crated when not actively working, and never tied out/left attached to anything other than a human. Limited crating space available inside, more outside, on grounds or in vehicles.

Food services: We will have a cold dish pot luck. Participants are welcome to bring a cold dish or desserts! A prize will be awarded for best dish and best dessert. Feel free to participate.

Payment and entry information: Entries will NOT be accepted without signatures and payment, entries are invalid without a signed Release Agreement Form. Owners are responsible for entry errors. Please write clearly and proof your entry. BHA will not make corrections once results are submitted. Incomplete forms, nonpayment, and returned checks are invalid entries. There is a \$25.00 fee for all returned checks. Entries accepted on a first come/first served basis.

Refunds are ONLY allowed if requested before the closing date of September 29, 2017

No event fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

BHA registration number is NOT required for a Fun Test!

However, you can register your dog on line at <http://www.barnhunt.com>. BHA registration fee is \$30, and is a lifetime fee for that dog. There are no annual fees with BHA, and no membership fees for dog owners.
